LETTER FROM KIERA

Spring ushers in changes as we begin to turn things over and look at ways to create opportunities for new growth. Our staff has developed several new programs for this season that we hope you will enjoy. There will also be physical changes to the senior center as we begin to align our program calendar and room schedule to support your creativity and reduce noise. On March 1, the second-floor lounge will shift into a space for scheduled classes and activities. PARKING TICKETING SYSTEM

Parking in the parking garage is free with a validation card. Validation cards are available to registered participants attending one of our programs or a meeting with Senior Center staff.

Participants are required to take a ticket upon entrance of parking garage. Parking is available on P-1 and is based on availability. Obtain parking validation card at the front desk of the Senior Center to exit the garage. If you do not obtain a parking validation card, you will need to pay for parking to exit.
