Drop-In Case Management:

Get assistance signing up for benefits, housing information, caregiver assistance, health and mental health services, and more. Sign up for an appointment through our kiosk at the front desk. Appointments are based on availability, Monday & Wednesday, 1:30PM–4:30PM, and Tuesday & Thursday, 9:30AM–12:30PM.

Shower & Laundry Facilities:

Showers and laundry are available for free for registered senior participants Monday through Friday from 9:30 AM–12:30 PM and 3–4:30 PM Sign up at the kiosk at the front desk. Shower and laundry facilities are dropin and based on availability.

Cyber Center:
