


# Senior Services is here for you!

#### **Shower & Laundry Facilities:**

Showers and laundry are available free of charge for registered senior participants Monday 9:30AM–12:30PM, Tuesday–Friday from 9:30AM–12:30PM and 3–4:30PM. Sign up at the kiosk at the front desk. Shower and laundry facilities are drop-in and based on availability. \*Laundry available every other day.

#### **Cyber Center:**

#### PARKING TICKETING SYSTEM
