
Senior Services is here for you!

Shower & Laundry Facilities:

Showers and laundry are available free of charge for registered senior participants Monday 9:30AM–12:30PM, Tuesday–Friday from 9:30AM–12:30PM and 3–4:30PM. Sign up at the kiosk at the front desk. Shower and laundry facilities are drop-in and based on availability. *Laundry available every other day.

Cyber Center:

The Cyber Center is open for computer use on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays, from 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM and 2:00 PM to 5:00 PM, based on availability. Location: The Village,1125 N. McCadden Pl., Los Angeles, CA 90038.





PARKING TICKETING SYSTEM







Dear Senior Services Clients.


