# LETTER FROM KIERA

Starting this month, we will be adjusting our operating hours across our locations to 9-3pm and our pantry hours will change to Thursdays from 9:30-11:00. September has a number of amazing arts, film and cultural events to participate in. On September 13 from 6-9pm we will screen AIDS DIVA: The Legend of Connie Norman. The screening is an official event of the 40th Anniversary of the founding of the City of West Hollywood. The life story of transgender / AIDS activist Connie Norman is intertwined with the city in the late 80's and early 90s, as West Hollywood repeatedly appears in the film in the key role of 'home territory' and stage for the LGBTQ community. A very special Q and A panel following the screening will include Connie Norma's activist colleagues gathered together live on stage for the first time since the film's premiere.

Additional featured events this month include an End of Summer dance; Songwriting for Seniors; Monoprinting with Mary-Linn, All the World's Stage Final Performance and an annual favorite cultural event, *Celebrando Nuestras Culturas*.

A very special Q and A panel following the screening will include Connie Norma's activist colleagues gathered together live on stage for the first time since the film's premiere during the pandemic in 2021.
