LETTER FROM KIERA

When I first started at the Center, one of the first things I did was sit in on our LGBTQ+ veterans group. I listened to members share memories of their service, and heard them talk about the trauma and disappointment they experienced after being less-than-honorably discharged due to their sexual orientation or gender identity.

In the years since, we've seen slow but steady progress as the Center worked to connect veterans to legal resources to have these discharges reversed—many of them successfully under the previous administration. I saw these changes positively impact the lives of the LGBTQ+ veterans in our program firsthand, allowing them to access vital benefits and services.

However, since January, we have seen these policies start moving backward. Active duty service members are being fired and losing the benefits they earned over years of service to our country. But LGBTQ+ service members deserve our support, and we will continue to advocate on their behalf.
