### DEAR FRIENDS:

In the lives of many LGBT people there were two particularly defining events in 2016: Donald Trump's election and the massacre of 49 people at Pulse, a predominately LGBT nightclub in Orlando. Though there's no comparing the two events, the Los Angeles LGBT Center's response to each is representative of the important role it plays in the community.

The public began to learn the horrifying details of the Pulse nightclub massacre the morning of the L.A. Pride Parade. Throughout the day, after revamping our parade contingent to show solidarity with Orlando, we spoke out in local and national news media to challenge early, and ultimately false reports, that the attack was coordinated or inspired by Muslim terrorist organizations. We put the spotlight on some of the biggest culprits for inciting violence: anti-LGBT political and religious leaders right here at home.

The next evening the Center hosted a rally that brought together up to 6,000 people of all races, ages, sexual orientations and gender identities to begin healing the wounded hearts and spirits of the many who were grief struck by the horrible tragedy. Months later we brought people together for an event, in conjunction with the Wallis Annenberg Center for Performing Arts, that celebrated the lives of those lost and raised nearly \$50,000 for the LGBT center in Orlando.

Donald Trump's election as president was a different type of crisis for many in our community.

The morning after his election—and for weeks afterward—our switchboard and staff were flooded with inquiries from people concerned about their marriage (or future ability to marry), their healthcare coverage, their immigration status, and much more. Many of the homeless youth who live with us, some of them immigrants, were inconsolable. Transgender people turned to us for immediate help to

complete the legal paperwork to change their gender and our pharmacy was busier than ever with people re-filling prescriptions, worried they'd soon lose their healthcare.

We hastily arranged a community gathering the evening after the election and, with just a few hours-notice, many hundreds of people filled the courtyard and galleries of the Center's Village at Ed Gould Plaza to find solace and comfort from each other, to better understand what a Trump presidency would mean for them, and to learn what they could do in response. Our incredible representative in Congress, Rep. Adam Schiff, dropped by and pledged to continue fighting for LGBT people.

Of course, we didn't have all the answers regarding the impact of this new administration and conservative Congress and we still don't. But based on the campaign promises of the president and leaders in Congress, the threats to LGBT people—and to federal funding for the Center's services and programs—are numerous. So we're more grateful than ever for the ongoing support of donors like you.

Helping to heal the LGBT community from the wounds of a bigoted society is something we've been doing since 1969, but more than that, we're working to build a world where LGBT people thrive as healthy, equal and complete members of society. No organization does more for LGBT people than your Center and we've never been able to do more—and serve more people—than we were able to do in 2016, thanks to our incredible donors.

### ERIKA KLETZIN

ERIKA KLETZIN, 77, HAD LIVED IN HER COZY SANTA MONICA HOME FOR TWO YEARS BEFORE HER RENT SKYROCKETED TO A RATE SHE COULD NO LONGER AFFORD. HAD THE CENTER'S TRIANGLE SQUARE IN HOLLYWOOD—THE NATION'S LARGEST AFFORDABLE HOUSING DEVELOPMENT SPECIFICALLY FOR LGBT SENIORS—NOT BEEN AVAILABLE FOR HER, THE FORMER NURSE AND ARTIST MAY HAVE ENDED UP HOMELESS.

"I believe things happen for a reason," she said. "I was meant to move into Triangle Square because it's centrally located to everything I need. When I had to give up my car, I was devastated, but really, everything is just a short distance away."

Accustomed to being independent and self-sufficient, Kletzin discovered that Triangle Square provided the community that she needed—not just a roof over her head. She also has access to the Center's Senior Services, which provides life-enriching programs and support services, activities, and events, ranging from lunches at The Village at Ed Gould Plaza to field trips to local museums and attractions.

"My neighbors at Triangle Square and the friends I've made through the Center's Senior Services program are like family," said Kletzin, who once married a man to appease her mother who disapproved of 66

her being lesbian. "They really understand what it means to be LGBT, and I've never felt the need to go back into the closet."

"No organization offers a wider array of programs, services, and events specifically for LGBT seniors than the Center," said Senior Services Deputy Director Tripp Mills. "Our department consists of experts who know how to help seniors stay active and feel invigorated. We know how

to navigate the complex world of Social Security, Medicare, veterans benefits, affordable housing, and more. "

Originally from Berlin, Germany, Kletzin and her family emigrated to the United States after World War II and settled in New Jersey. She pursued a nursing career after graduating from high school and worked as an LVN and RN for 42 years, primarily helping people to recover from alcohol and drug abuse. For decades, Kletzin took care of others. Now, the Center is taking care of her.

"I worry about money a lot, but I know that some of my friends and neighbors have had it much worse in life," said Kletzin, whose home is adorned with her artwork. "Thank goodness for Triangle Square and the Center for providing programs for LGBT people of my generation. The companionship I've found here is incomparable."

"All I could think of was to go home, pack up my belongings, flee to another city, and figure out how to communicate with my family," said Flores, 28. "Although I was going to leave my friends and relatives behind, I had to save myself."

Flores began working as an HIV/AIDS educator when he was a teenager, but his rising prominence as an LGBT activist was met with hatred by some in his community. For years he put up with the discrimination, taunts and threats, but after the violent confrontation with the group of masked men two years ago, he knew he could never safely live in Honduras, even if he moved to another town.

"Discrimination against LGBT Hondurans begins at an early age, when boys and girls are expected to conform to strict gender expectations," Flores explained. "Access to health care is denied to LGBT people simply because of their

sexual orientation or gender identity, and many employers don't want to hire an LGBT person. As a result, many of us end up working in the factories... or the streets."

When he arrived in Los Angeles, Flores sought assistance from the Los Angeles LGBT Center's Legal Services program, which provides legal assistance, including representation, to asylum seekers.

"Los Angeles has one of the largest  ${\sf LGBT}$  refugee populations in the country

due both to our location and our large number of out LGBT people," said Director of Legal Services Roger Coggan. "As the largest LGBT service provider in the world, the Center is a magnet for many of these survivors of persecution and torture—from Central America to the Middle East. Each year, our work has helped dozens of refugees and asylum seekers be able to stay in the safest environment they have known."

After 15 months of representation by Center staff which navigated his case through the legal system, Flores was granted asylum in December 2016. He now has the opportunity to apply for permanent residency.

"With this asylum order, my life is forever changed—I can be who I am without fear," he says. "But, my life really became better once I first stepped foot into the United States and walked through the Center's doors."

### WE STAND WITH ORLANDO

The deadliest mass shooting in U.S. history happened in the early morning hours of June 12 at the Pulse nightclub in Orlando. Later that morning, the Center led its contingent in the L.A. Pride parade with signs spelling out Orlando as a show of support and solidarity.

The next day, thousands gathered with us and Lady Gaga on the steps of L.A. City Hall for a rally and vigil. The Center also partnered with The Wallis Annenberg Center for the Performing Arts for United FORlando, a performance and panel discussion that raised support for victims of the tragedy.



### July

### PUBLIC HEALTH RESPONSE

In response to the second outbreak of meningitis among gay and bisexual men in Los Angeles, the Center launched a campaign to promote vaccinations, beginning with a news conference at The Village at Ed Gould Plaza that included public health officials and representatives from other LGBT health organizations. We began offering free vaccinations at our clinics in Hollywood and at the Center-WeHo.

### IT'S (NOW) THE LAW

Landmark legislation sponsored by the Center and APLA Health to boost awareness of pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) and post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) was signed into law, ensuring that when people test negative for HIV they'll receive information about how to protect themselves from infection through PrEP and PEP.

### The Protecting Youth from Institutional Abuse Act

became law in California, regulating the industry of residential programs that claim to help "troubled" youth, including those who are simply LGBT. It's the most comprehensive law of its kind, with no exemptions for religiousbased businesses. Survivors of Institutional Abuse (SIA) joined the Center in sponsoring the bill.

### WE ASKED, YOU JOINED

Supporters joined the conversation on our social media channels in record numbers this year. The Center's channels grew nearly 15% on Facebook, 12% on Twitter, 120% on Instagram, and 83% on YouTube, bringing our total social audience reach to nearly 188,000 and total social engagement to nearly 400,000.

### TRANSGENDER AWARENESS

June A record 1,600 people attended the Center's 18th annual Trans Pride L.A., one of the country's oldest and largest celebrations of the trans community, with special appearances by CeCe McDonald and Sir Lady Java. It was funded in part through the generosity of Amazon Original Series Transparent.

Our Transgender Youth
Cot Employment Toolkit

is a resource for case managers working to help transgender youth find jobs. Our Transgender Economic Empowerment Project held its annual job fair in October, welcoming nearly four dozen companies and hundreds of job seekers.



### **HERE WE GROW**

The first public renderings of the Center's new Anita


May Rosenstein Campus were released. The revolutionary campus will become the Center's new administrative headquarters and will include expanded emergency housing for youth, affordable housing for youth and seniors, new senior and youth centers, and ground floor retail space.

With a groundbreaking scheduled early in 2017, the project has been unanimously approved by the L.A. City Plannning Commission and approved by the full L.A. City Council.



The Center expanded its charter high school for LGBT youth to five days a week through a new partnership with Five Keys charter school, providing a place for students who didn't feel safe or comfortable in traditional schools.

To provide clients with even faster service, the Center opened a new, larger pharmacy in the McDonald/Wright building, adding additional staff and two new service windows. One of the things that distinguishes the Center's pharmacy from others is that it's completely integrated with each client's medical record, enabling staff to double-check prescription orders to protect against potential complications.









### CAPITAL CAMPAIGN FOR

### ANITA MAY ROSENSTEIN CAMPUS

The Center is engaged in an ambitious campaign to raise \$47.5 million or more for the beautiful new Anita May Rosenstein Campus, scheduled to open in early 2019 directly across the street from The Village at Ed Gould Plaza.

To help meet the growing need among LGBT youth and seniors for housing, support and social services, the new campus will increase our emergency housing capacity by 67%, our transitional housing capacity by 150% and our senior affordable housing units by 96%.

### THE NEW 216,000 S.F. CAMPUS WILL INCLUDE:

- 100 beds for homeless youth
- Up to 85 units of affordable housing for seniors
- Up to 35 units of permanent supportive housing for young people
- Youth drop-in center providing meals, showers, clothing and wide range of support services
- Community meeting rooms
- Multi-generational meeting, dining and recreational areas
- Facilities for:

o Support groups

o Case management

o Counseling

o Job training & placement

o Educational programs

o Mentoring & leadership

programs

The campus will also be the Center's new administrative headquarters, freeing space in the McDonald/Wright Building to become entirely a health and medical center, thereby enabling us to meet the growing demand for health-related services including medical care, mental health, addiction recovery, HIV/STD testing and treatment and much more.




